Two Avenues: The class may be taken...

On-site: Classes will be held at the West Virginia School of Preaching facility in Moundsville, WV.

On-line: Those who take it online will have a streaming link sent to them early in the day of the class. They can then click on it to open access the class as it occurs. Those who might be busy at that time can later access the recorded class on the WVSOP YouTube channel with the same link.

A class syllabus and requirements will be sent after one signs up for the class.
